KINDERGARTEN

(please label this one item with first & last name, teacher's name and room #)

1st – 3rd Grade Parents

Accelerated Reader is designed to be part of a comprehensive reading program. It does not replace classroom instruction and district instructional materials, rather it supports and enhances them by practice. Reading practice enables students to apply the skills and strategies being covered.

We feel this program is an important part of our students' learning and an accurate way for our teachers to monitor learning, so we are requesting a small donation from each student in grades 1st-3rd to cover a portion of the cost for the 2017 – 2018 school year.

4th – 6th Grade Parents

AVID stands for Advancement Via Individual Determination. AVID Elementary is designed to be embedded into the daily instruction of all elementary classrooms, across entire grade levels, to impact school-wide structures. AVID Elementary Essentials focus on the four necessary areas to ensure that all students are poised for academic success: **Instruction, Culture, Leadership, and Systems**.

AVID Elementary incorporates:

Student Success Skills – encompassing communication skills (e.g. listening, speaking, writing), self-advocacy skills, note-taking strategies, critical thinking, and study skills.

Organizational Skills – both mental and physical; students learn to use organizational tools, as well as learn and practice skills around time management and goal-setting.

WICOR Lessons – emphasize instruction on writing to learn, inquiry, collaboration, organization, and reading to learn in all content areas.

Partnerships – among students, classrooms, grade levels, schools, feeder patterns, families, and communities.

We will be focusing very strongly on organizational skills and student success skills for fourth, fifth, and sixth graders. Each student in 4th, 5th, and 6th grades will be required to have an AVID binder (these will be available for purchase at meet the teacher night on July 31st as well as the Peter Piper class list sneak peek on July 28th). The notebook will be divided into the four specific subjects. All subjects will be color-coded (math=blue, language arts=purple, science=green, social studies=gray) and students will learn note-taking skills to correspond with the subjects. Each binder will also have a pencil pouch that will contain all needed supplies. As students rotate from class to class we feel that this organizational tool will set them up for academic success.
